<u>Current member of the MHSIBCA must be listed on this form.</u> Please nominate any student athlete whom you feel is worthy of consideration. This application includes four teams selected for each division; First Team, Second Team, Third Team and All Academic (seniors only).

Reminder: Coaches or other school representative submitting applications must be a member of the MHSIBCA by February 10, 2019.

Applications must be filled out completely in order to be considered.

General Information

- Only athletes whose coaches or athletic directors are current members of the MHSIBCA can be nominated and eligible for this award.
- All State Teams will be selected for Divsions I, II, III and IV, including a first team, second team and third team for each division. Points will decide placement on which team.
- All student athletes meeting criteria are eligible (multiple athletes from a school could make these teams). Athletes who have been suspended for an MHSAA rule violation are ineligible.
- All nominated bowlers must have bowled 13 regular season games to be eligible. Conference singles games shall be included. Invitational and other tournament games are not counted.
- Coaches must submit a final league sheet for each bowler nominated along with a completed application. The coach is required to fill out the applications and the committee must be able to reach him/her in the event that clarification is needed.
- Any information that is not verified (league sheet, transcript, etc) will not be used for point total.
- Seniors only are eligible for the academic teams (3.55 GPA or higher) and dream team.
- Applications must be returned to the All State Team/Academic Committee upon completion of the Regular Season Competition. See mailing instructions below.

State Singles Tournament Points

Points will be awarded to bowlers placing in the top 25 places for their division's singles competition. Position 1-16 will be awarded based on match play competition. State Champion will receive 25 points. The finalists will receive 24 points. Positions 3-16 will be determined by the score of the two games bowled in which they were eliminated (ex: in the semi-finals, the losers would receive 3rd and 4th place, 4th place as determined by the bowlers whose two game total is the lowest). Positions 17-25 will be based on the individuals finish in the qualifying round.

General Information

- Only teams whose coaches or athletic directors are current members of the MHSIBCA are eligible to be nominated for this award.
- Teams meeting the eligibility requirements (combined 3.65 GPA) will receive Academic All State Team certificates.
- Athletes who have been suspended for an MHSAA rule violation are ineligible to be considered toward the team criteria. Exchange students are ineligible to be considered toward the team criteria.
- Coaches must submit a transcript for each student athlete used toward the team criteria.
- Any information that is not verified (copy of the regional roster, transcript, etc) will not be used.
- Applications must be returned to the All State Team/Academic Committee by the **deadline of March 8, 2019**.

TEAM CRITERIA

- 1. Use six members of the same team who competed in the MHSAA Regional Tournament.
- 2. Minimum combined average of 3.65 on a 4.0 scale (GPA's will automatically be calculated)
- 3. Players with all A's receive bonus points according to their grade level, (i.e. 10th graders receive 4.05, 11th graders receive 4.10, and 12 graders 4.15)
- 4. The six individual transcripts (as of 2/1/2019) must be mailed and confirmed as received to verify grade point averages. 8th grade transcripts will be used for freshmen boys and girls.
- 5. Teams that achieve Academic All State Status will be awarded with a certificate of achievement which will be sent to the Athletic Director. The team's name will be listed in the MHSIBCA Spring Awards Banquet Program. Only one certificate per team will be awarded.
