## TOURNAMENT FORMAT

1. Teams will be assigned lanes on a random draw.
2. Fifteen minutes of practice will be allowed prior to the start of the first game. No additional practice time will be allowed until the Match Play portion of the tournament.
3. Athletes will bowl three (3) games and two (2) baker matches on five (5) different pairs of lanes. Follow lane assignments on the recaps. Competitors are asked to observe one-lane courtesy.
4. After completing 3 regular games, teams will move again for the first baker match (2 baker games) and then one more time for the last baker match (2 baker games). Please follow lane assignments on the recap sheet.
5. The Baker Format uses the lead-off bowler to bowl frames 1 and 6, the second bowler to bowl frames 2 and 7, and so on. The position of each bowler in the line-up may be changed for each game.
6. There will be a 30 minute break after the qualifier. This will allow tournament officials time to tally up all scores and determine which teams will continue on to the Match Play competition.
7. The cut to the second round or Match Play will be the top 8 teams, based on total pin fall from the first round. If there is a tie for 8th place - the tie will be broken by 1 baker game. Number of teams for JV Match Play will be determined by the number of entrants.
8. Teams will be seeded into the NCAA format for Match Play competition. Teams will bowl 2 head-to-head Baker games with total pins determining the winner to advance to the next round. In the event of a tie, there will be a five-frame (6 thru 10) Baker roll-off on the 2nd game. Match Play elimination will continue until first place and a runner up is determined. Trophies will be awarded to the highest team and the runner up in both the boys and girls divisions.

## TOURNAMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. MHSAA and USBC rules and regulations will govern this tournament.
2. Closing date for entries is Wednesday, January 3, 2020 ★
3. This event will be contested on the ALLEN lane pattern
4. This event is open to all current high schools that have a varsity or junior varsity team entered in MHSAA competition for the 2019-2020 high school bowling season.
5. Only registered bowler may participate. An active team shall consist of five bowlers. Up to three alternates are permitted. Substitution will be allowed as follows:
  - a. Starting bowlers must bowl at least one frame in a given game.
  - b. Once a substitute enters the game he/she must complete that game.
  - c. Mid-frame substitution is permitted.
  - d. The bowler who has been substituted for must sit out the remainder of that game but is allowed to return as a starter or a substitute in subsequent games.
  - e. The substitute must be on the original tournament roster.
6. Entry fee is \$100 per team. There are no refunds. Checks returned for insufficient funds will be assessed a \$40 fee. A bowler may only bowl for his/her school. School ID is required and should be with the bowler at all times.
7. This is a scratch tournament. No handicap.
8. All coaches will be required to sign score sheets. Any scoring errors must be reported to the tournament director immediately. Only tournament officials can make score changes.
9. No prize money will be collected or awarded. A team trophy will be awarded to the winning team in each division for both boys and girls. Medals will be awarded to the top three games/series in each division for both boys and girls. Individuals will receive medals for all qualifying scores (*maximum of one medal per individual* rule has been changed).
10. Teams are required to check in at the tournament office one hour prior to the start of tournament competition.
11. All equipment used must comply with USBC regulations. Use of illegal equipment will constitute a forfeit and scores will be discarded.
12. All bowlers for each school should be dressed similarly. Same shirts and same color pants. School shirts must bear the school name and logo. Hats, jeans, and all mobile devices (iPhones, etc.) are prohibited.
13. Only registered bowlers and coaches are permitted in the bowling/settee area.
14. Any bowler/team arriving after the start of competition shall begin play in the game/frame currently being bowled. Makeup of missed frames is strictly prohibited.
15. No tobacco products or alcoholic beverages are permitted. Outside food or drinks are not allowed.
16. Bowlers are not allowed to use or play amusement games during competition.
17. This tournament will be conducted in the spirit of fair and honorable competition. Unsportsmanlike conduct (profanity, rooting against competition, etc.) will not be tolerated under any circumstances. Penalty will be enforced up to and including forfeiture of tournament placing and refusal of entry for future competitions.
18. Any disputes during the tournament or exceptions to the above rules and regulations will be resolved at the discretion of the tournament officials. All such decisions are final.
