Rules & Regulations

1. MHSAA rules of eligibility and USBC rules will govern this tournament.
2. This event is open to all current high schools that have a Varsity and/or JV bowling program in high school competition.
3. Only registered bowlers may bowl.
4. Bowlers may only compete for their school as listed and verified on the entry form.
5. Competition will be held in the following divisions: Varsity Boys, Varsity Girls, JV Boys, and JV Girls.
6. **BOWLER ENTRY:** A fee of \$25 per bowler **must** accompany the entry. **NO REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED.** Checks returned for insufficient funds will be assessed a \$25 fee.
7. All coaches (or designated coaches) will be required to sign score sheets. Errors in scoring must be reported to the Tournament Manager immediately. Any changes in scoring can only be made by the tournament management.
8. Bowlers will check-in with the tournament office upon arrival. Bowlers should report not less than 30 minutes before squad time.
9. All equipment used in the tournament must meet USBC specifications. Illegal equipment will constitute a forfeit and scores for that event will be disallowed.
10. **BOWLING ATTIRE:** All bowlers should be dressed alike in shirts and the same color pants (team uniforms). School shirts must reflect the name of the school and/or the school logo or mascot. Exceptions will be allowed if a team is unable to obtain jerseys prior to tournament date. **No Yoga pants or stretch pants allowed.**
11. Only registered bowling team members will be allowed in the immediate bowling area.
12. Tardy bowlers: Bowling shall begin in accordance with a previously-arranged schedule, unless the Tournament Manager authorizes a delay. Any player or team arriving late shall begin play with the score counting beginning with the frame and game then being bowled. All frames missed will be assessed zero points.
13. No tobacco products, drinking of alcoholic beverages or unsportsmanlike conduct will be permitted while participating in the event. Outside food and drinks are **NOT** allowed to be brought into the center. Bowlers will not be permitted the use of amusement games or pool tables during his or her competition.
14. Any disputes during the tournament or exceptions to the above Rules and Regulations will be resolved at the discretion of the Tournament Manager and/or the Tournament Committee.

Utica High School Singles Jingles Tournament **Registration: 7:00 a.m.**

1. Tournament divisions are as follows: Varsity Boys, JV Boys, Varsity Girls, JV Girls.
2. Event will be 4 games of singles play to qualify for the single elimination finals.
3. Lane assignments will be pre-assigned by the Tournament Committee prior to check-in.
4. At 8:00 a.m. a 10-minute practice session will begin.
5. Bowlers will bowl 4 regular games across 4 lanes. Even number lane assignments will move one pair to the right. Odd number lane assignments will move one pair to the left. One lane courtesy should be observed during competition.
6. There will be a 45-minute meal break after the qualifier. No outside food or beverage will be allowed into the bowling center. Food will be available for purchase.
7. After the meal break, singles awards will be presented. Awards from qualifying will be: Top Qualifiers (8) for Varsity Boys, Varsity Girls, JV Boys, & JV Girls, and High Game (1) for Boy and Girls. Following the awards, a 5-minute practice session will begin for final competition. The field will have been cut to the top **16** individuals, or an appropriate number based on entries. The tiebreaker for any seeding 1-16 will be the highest qualifying game score for each individual.
8. The competition will proceed with each of the finalists bowling 1 game. After each game, the field of finalists will be cut in half, with the highest scores from the group advancing to the next round. Any ties effecting advancement to the next round will be broken by a 9th and 10th frame roll-off. The last 2 finalists will bowl 1 game to decide the champion. In case of a tie at the end of that match, a 9th and 10th frame roll-off will decide the winner.
9. The awards presentation will immediately follow the end of competition. Awards will be presented to the top 4 finalists from each division.
10. **Registration deadline is December 22, 2019.**
