- Mid-Frame Substitution will be allowed, removed bowler cannot return to that game
- Qualifying - Teams will bowl (2) 5 Game Individual Sets
- Qualifying - Teams will bowl (1) 4 Game Baker Set
- Teams will move after each set
- Top 8 Boys* Teams and Top 8* Girls Teams will advance to Elimination Round
 - *Based on 32 total teams
- Elimination Round: Head-to-Head, Teams will bowl 2 BAKER MATCHES, Total Pins
- In the event of a tie, each team will select two bowlers, One Ball Each, Total Pins
- All MHSAA rules will be followed
- Tournament committee's decision will be final on all disputes.
- KEGEL Phantom 2 Pattern will be used in competition
- Top 4 Teams in each division will receive medals, Awards for Championship Teams
